7. Such other criteria that the selection committee may approve.

The criteria may change, so any applicant should contact the DSC office for the latest requirements. The animals required for the Malek Award will not be an acceptable criterion.

Info Box:

All animals must have been taken when legally huntable in the country of origin at the time they were collected. Females of a species will be acceptable in those species where both sexes are similar in appearance. Exotics from North America will not be accepted, except a free-range aoudad, red sheep or Armenian sheep.

These criteria aim to honor the different species mentioned, imparting additional value to sustaining the population for the future.
